Time commitment	 The museum is open Tuesday-Sunday 10am to 4pm from April to October and at weekends throughout the winter. There are two shifts per day: 9.30am - 1pm 1pm - 4.30pm No minimum commitment as to the number of shifts, whatever suits your availability
