

EYAM VISITORS' GUIDE: USEFUL INFORMATION FOR ORGANISED PARTIES

Welcome to the historic village of Eyam, where we hope you will enjoy your stay. We would like to inform you of the facilities available in the village and how to make best use of them during your visit.

EYAM SPORTS ASSOCIATION LTD (CHARITY NO. 1123735)

We are a village charity, staffed by local volunteers, that raises funds to maintain the pavilion, cricket pitch, MUGA (multi-use games area) football pitch and children's play area. These ARE NOT FUNDED by the local district council, although the Parish Council pays £1,000 towards the maintenance of the children's play area.

HOW DOES THIS AFFECT YOU?

You will need to make a booking if your party wants to make use of the pavilion, cricket pitch, MUGA or football pitch for any organised activities. If, however, you make use of these areas on a casual basis (e.g. a picnic), a donation would be greatly appreciated. You will find envelopes in Eyam Museum into which your donation may be placed along with an address or e-mail should you require a receipt.

If any members of your party use the play apparatus, please ensure that they are supervised, that they do not overload the play equipment and treat the area respectfully. The play area is a popular local resource used by both locals and visitors alike, so your cooperation will help to prolong the life of the play equipment.

Finally, please ensure that all litter is removed and placed into the bins provided.

BOOKINGS

If you want to book the pavilion, cricket pitch, MUGA or football pitch or require further information, please email sangatbans@btinternet.com. The cost will be in the region of £20 per hour.

In the case of inclement weather, the local village hall is available for bookings; the hall can seat up to 50 people and the facilities include toilets and kitchen area for you to use.
